Sub: IEDSS-2009-10-C.S.S. – Therapeutic Services to students of children with special needs (CWSN) – Sanction accorded – Orders issued – Reg.

As per the ref (iii) cited, Government of India has sanctioned Rs.26,60,000/- to provide therapeutic services to children with special needs (CWSN) as proposed by the State Government. Under this item, various therapeutic services like speech therapy, physiotherapy, occupational therapy etc. can be provided as per the requirement. Support can be made at cluster level and needs of children with disabilities in a cluster of schools can be addressed.

Hence it is decided to start therapeutic units in 19 schools where resource centre or resource room facility is already provided.

The equipments for the therapeutic services are to be purchased according to the needs of the beneficiary. The remuneration for the trainer is also to be met from the fund provided for the purpose.

Hence sanction is hereby accorded for the release of Rs.26,60,000/- (Rupees twenty six lakhs and sixty thousand only) @Rs.1,40,000/- per school to start therapeutic units in the existing Resource Centre/Room. The fund for the purpose will be debited to the Head of Account 2235-02-101-95-34-OC (Plan) from the current year budget provision.

BG-section of this Directorate is requested to place an amount of Rs.26,60,000/- (Rupees twenty six lakhs sixty thousand only) to the Deputy Directors of Education concerned who will re-allot the same to the DEOs concerned. DEOs will draw and disburse the fund to the Head Masters of the schools mentioned above by way of demand draft as most urgent. The fund may be disbursed to the DDEs as per the break-up given below:

The School PTA will implement the programme as per the advice and direction of the above committee which will also monitor the whole programme.
