PRESS NOTE

Sub: Sanction of Financial Assistance for education to the children of beedi/Lime Stone & Dolomite Mines/Cine workers for the year 2009-10

Labour welfare organization under Government of India, Ministry of Labour & Employment is extending financial assistance for education to the children of Beedi/Lime Stone & Dolomite Mines/Cine workers who are studying in Government schools or Government Recognised schools.

The eligibility condition to receive scholarship is:

- a) that family income does not exceed :
 - i) Rs.10,000/- per month in case of beedi workers
 - ii) Rs.8000/- per month or an amount not exceeding Rs.1 lakh per feature film where it is paid by way of lump sum for cine workers,
 - iii) Rs.10000/-pm in case of Lime Stone & Dolomite Mine workers employed in Supervisory and managerial capacity and there is no income ceiling limit for other category of mine workers.
- b) Students who have been promoted in the last qualifying examination.
- c) Students who have not received scholarship from any other source for the year.

Financial assistance is paid to the student per annum ranging from Rs.250/- to Rs.8000/- depending upon classes from I standard onwards to diploma/graduation/professional/technical/agriculture courses including post graduation. The heads of the educational institutions are advised to submit the details of the student who are seeking financial assistance in the prescribed format.

The head of the educational institutions are advised to follow the same procedure as laid down for the last academic year and send the proposals in the statement in the prescribed format to this office.

31st AUGUST 2009

INSTRUCTIONS

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Either of the parent of the student should be a Beedi/LS&D Mine/Cine worker with minimum 6 months continuous service.
2. Family income does not exceed Rs.10000/- in case of beedi workers and in case of Cine workers Rs.8000/- per month or an amount not exceeding Rs.1 lakh where it is paid by way of lumpsum or instalments. There is no income ceiling limit for mine workers.
3. Sons/daughters of contractors or supervisory staff are not eligible.(In case of mine workers those supervisory staff who are drawing less than Rs.10000/- are eligible)
4. The applicant must have passed the last qualifying examination.
5. Student who receives scholarship from any other source during 2009-10 will NOT be eligible for grant of financial assistance for education.

GUIDELINES FOR HEAD OF THE INSTITUTIONS:

1. The Head of the Institution should obtain duly filled application in the prescribed proforma which is enclosed from each student only once at their entry level. After obtaining of applications the details in the prescribed statement duly filed in all respects should be submitted alongwith the renewal cases.
2. All the private schools are required to enclose a Xerox copy of recognition/affiliation issued by the Competent Authority.
3. The statement should be prepared class wise in ascending order (viz.I,II,III etc)
4. The statement should be prepared separately Fundwise ie Beedi/Mine/Cine workers.
5. The consolidated statements should reach this office on or before 31st August 2009.
6. School/College code allotted by Labour welfare organisation should be invariably mentioned.
7. The Head of the institution should ensure the genuiness of the entitlement by verifying the records.
8. It is to be ensured that before submission of statement that previous years acquittances for disbursement of financial assistance is sent to this office.
9. The financial assistance will be stopped in case any educational institution furnish wrong information and liable for de-recognition by the Competent Authority.
10. The Head of Institution concerned shall be personally responsible for the proper disbursement of the financial assistance.

NOT ELIGIBLE

The Heads of the Institution are requested to cancel the financial assistance under the following circumstances:

- a) If the financial assistance is obtained on the basis of false statement.
- b) If the student discontinues his/her studies.
- c) In case of unsatisfactory progress/irregular attendance/guilty of misconduct/failed students.
- d) The parent ceases to be the employee of the Beedi/Mine/Cine Establishment.
- e) Student who after passing one stage of Education/professional course is studying the same stage of education in different subject/professional courses.
